For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues: But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will.

2 Cor 3:6

God has made us able ministers of the New Testament: not of the letter but of the Spirit. . .the Spirit gives life.

. . . By love serve one another.

and of justice and might, to declare to Jacob his transgression, and to Israel his sin.

Mic 5:8-9

The Lord has given me the tongue of the learned that I should know how to speak a word in season to him who is weary.

Is 51:16

I have put My words in your mouth; I have covered you with the shadow of My hand, that I may plant the heavens, lay the foundations of the earth, and say to Zion, "You are My people."

Is 60:1

Arise and shine for your light has come! The glory of the Lord has risen upon you.

Do not worry about how or what you shall speak; for it is not you who speak, but the Spirit of your Father who speaks in you,

Wilt thou then not be afraid of the power? do that which is good, and thou shalt have praise of the same: For he is the minister of God to thee for good. execute wrath upon him that doeth evil. Wherefore ye must needs be subject, not only for wrath, but also for conscience sake. For for this cause pay ye tribute also: for they are God's ministers, attending continually upon this very thing. Render therefore to all their dues: tribute to whom tribute is due; custom to whom custom; fear to whom fear; honour to whom honour.

(The governments, which are ordained or appointed by God, must do good, punish evil, use tax money right. This is justice. They are God's ministers or servants to attend to these things.)

Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your Throne; mercy and truth shall go before Your face
